Some county employees work in more than one county.

Here are some important facts:

- If you go from one county to another without more than a 30-day break in service, you remain in CERF.
- If you are employed in a CERF-eligible position in more than one county, CERF enrollment will need to be completed in both counties.
 Please contact your county clerk or CERF for additional information.
- If you are employed in multiple counties, contributions are required for each county. Your benefit will consider compensation from each county in which you worked.
- You are eligible for a refund of all contributions you paid if you are non-vested and have a break in employment of more than 30 days.
